Simplified Testing Policy

PRACTICAL EXAM

1. You must pass the practical exam with a minimum score of 70 to set for the written exam.
2. If you fail the practical exam on the first attempt, you can retest once more with no coaching from the instructor. If you fail a second time you will have to retake the complete course again.
3. Tested candidates must be separated from the untested candidates until the testing session is completed.

WRITTEN EXAM

1. Candidates must be seated one foot apart from each other.
2. Fill out the candidate's information on the response sheet.
3. There are _____ questions on the exam and you have _____ minutes to complete it.
4. You must make a 70 or better for a passing score.
5. Any candidate receiving less than a 70, they will be notify by the local delivery agency and allowed to retest once more at the local delivery agency.
6. Do not make any marks on the exam.
7. No talking during the exam and no cheating allowed. This will cause you to receive a failing score.
8. Radios and pagers on quite or off.
9. Bathroom Breaks. No phone calls or "Life lines" while on break. Flip over your response sheet before leaving the room.
10. Should you have a question about an exam question, raise your hand, I will come to you and only read the question out loud to you.
11. There is only one correct answer for each question. Unmarked and or two marked answers will be counted wrong.
12. If you want to change your marked answer, completely erase, or if you are using an ink pen, put an X mark through the one you want changed and mark your new choice.
13. Once you complete the exam, turn your exam & the response sheet and you can leave the room or remain at your seat quietly.
